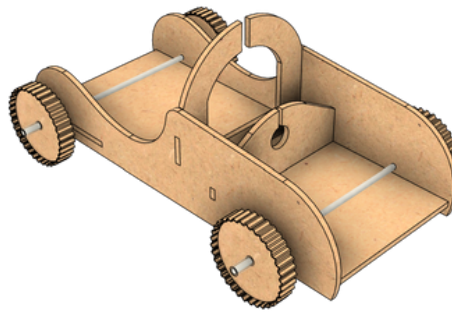
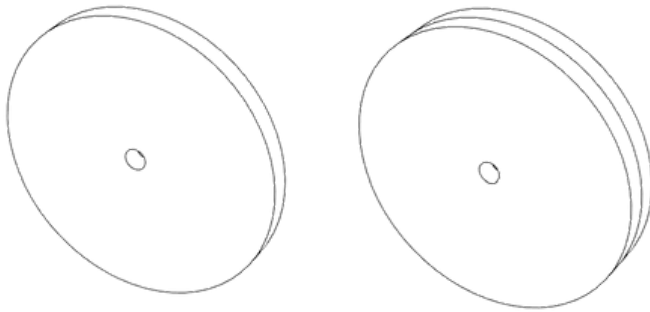


Balloon Rocket Car



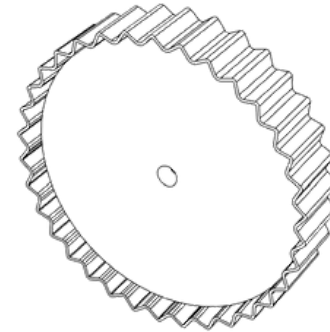
Follow each step in sequence and glue the pieces together as indicated in the images.

1



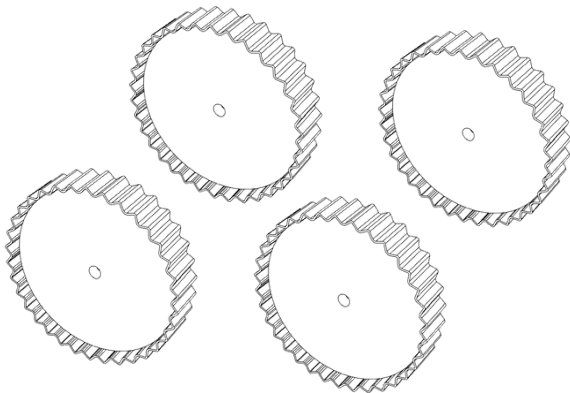
Start with 2 of your wheel circles, and glue them together. If some glue squeezes into the middle of the hole, use a skewer to clean it out.

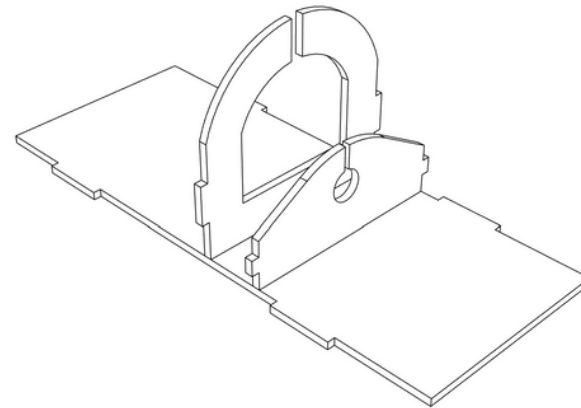
Take one of your corrugated strips, lay it out with the smooth side facing up and put a generous line of glue down the middle. Take your wheel from Step 1 and wrap the corrugated piece around it, pressing firmly. You can use a small elastic band to keep it in place while it dries.

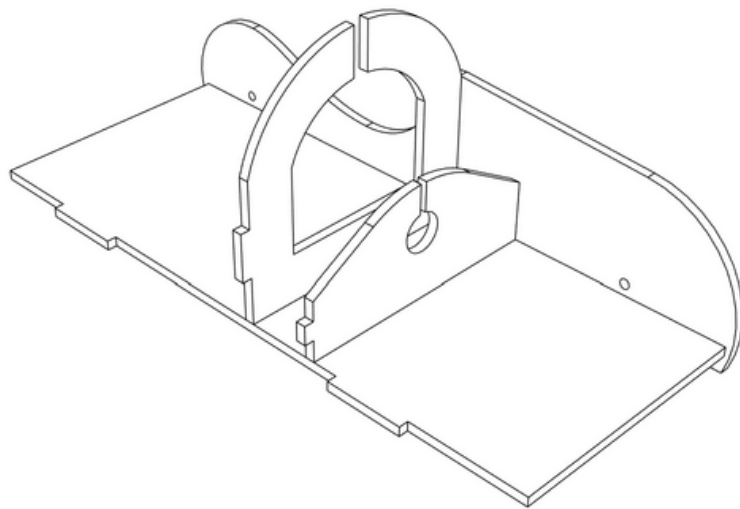
Repeat Steps 1 & 2 another 3 times, so that you end up with 4 full wheels. Set aside to dry. Once dry, you can remove the elastic bands.

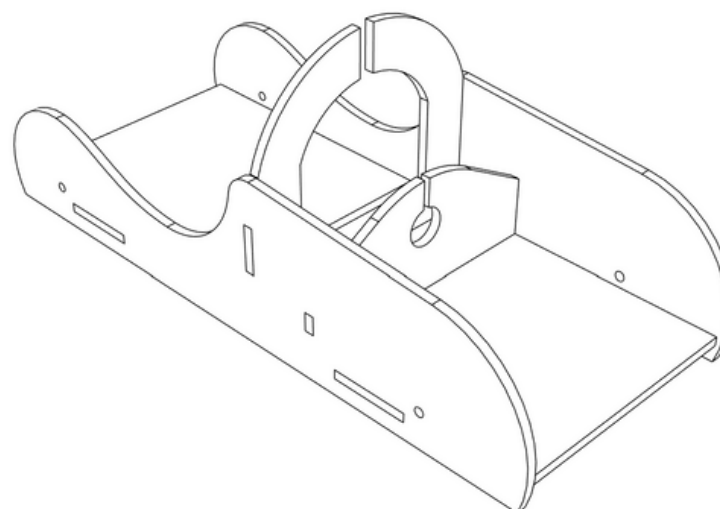
Take the base of your car, and glue the balloon holder with the small hole, and the balloon collar, and glue them into the base to match the image above.

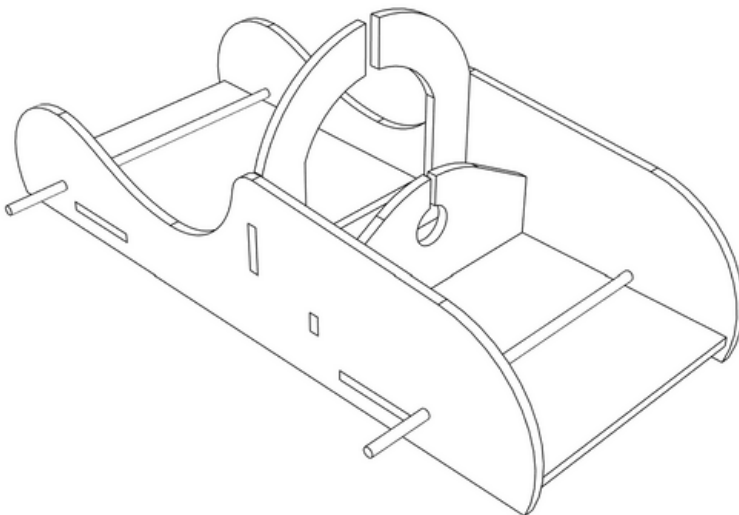
Take one of the side panels, and glue it to the base, slotting the tabs of your base into the slots of the side panel. You can flatten the tabs a bit to make them fit easier into the slots.

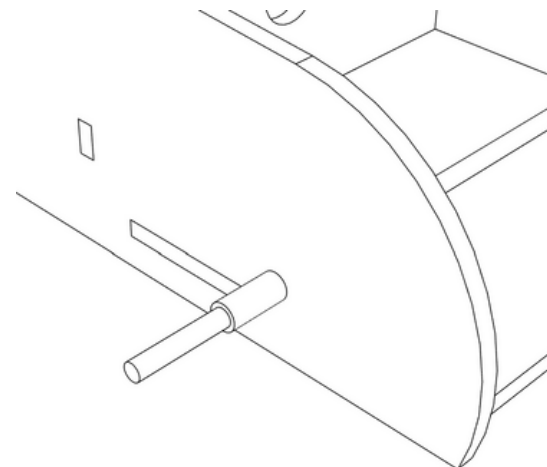
Now repeat Step 5 with the other side panel. Set aside to dry.

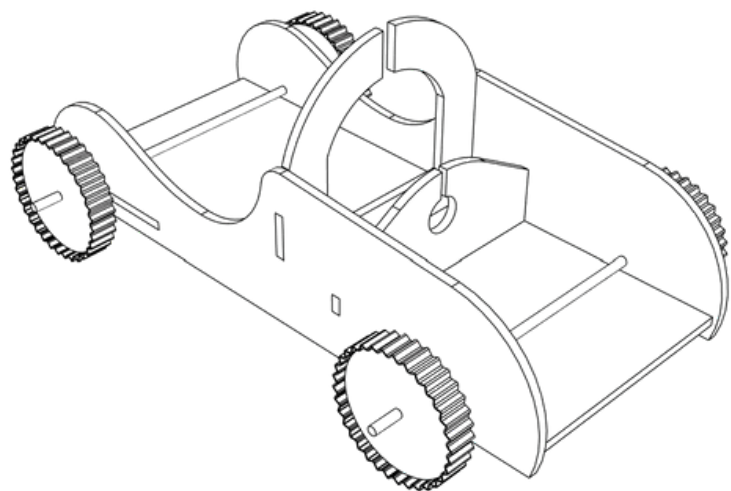
Cut 2 skewers to the length of 15cm, and thread them through the holes in your side panels, like in the image above.

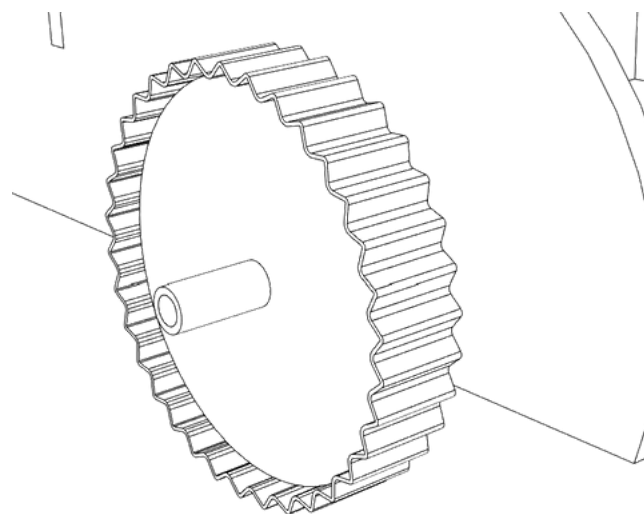
Take your plastic tube and cut 8 pieces of 1cm long each. Take 4 of the pieces, and slot one onto each end of the skewers.

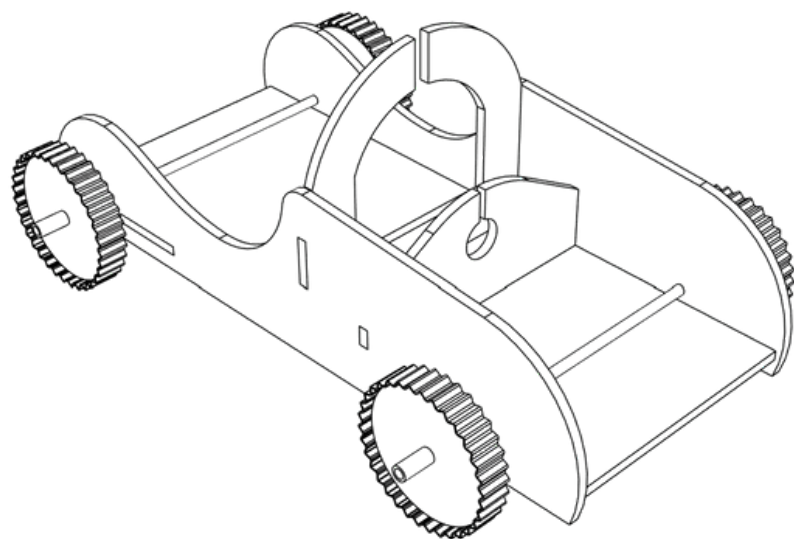
Slot your 4 wheels onto the 4 ends of the skewers.

Take your remaining 4 plastic tube pieces. Put a small blob of Curious Gum into the opening of each piece of tube. Slot the tube over the end of the skewer, making sure the Curious Gum seals the tube onto the end of the skewer, keeping the wheel on the skewer.

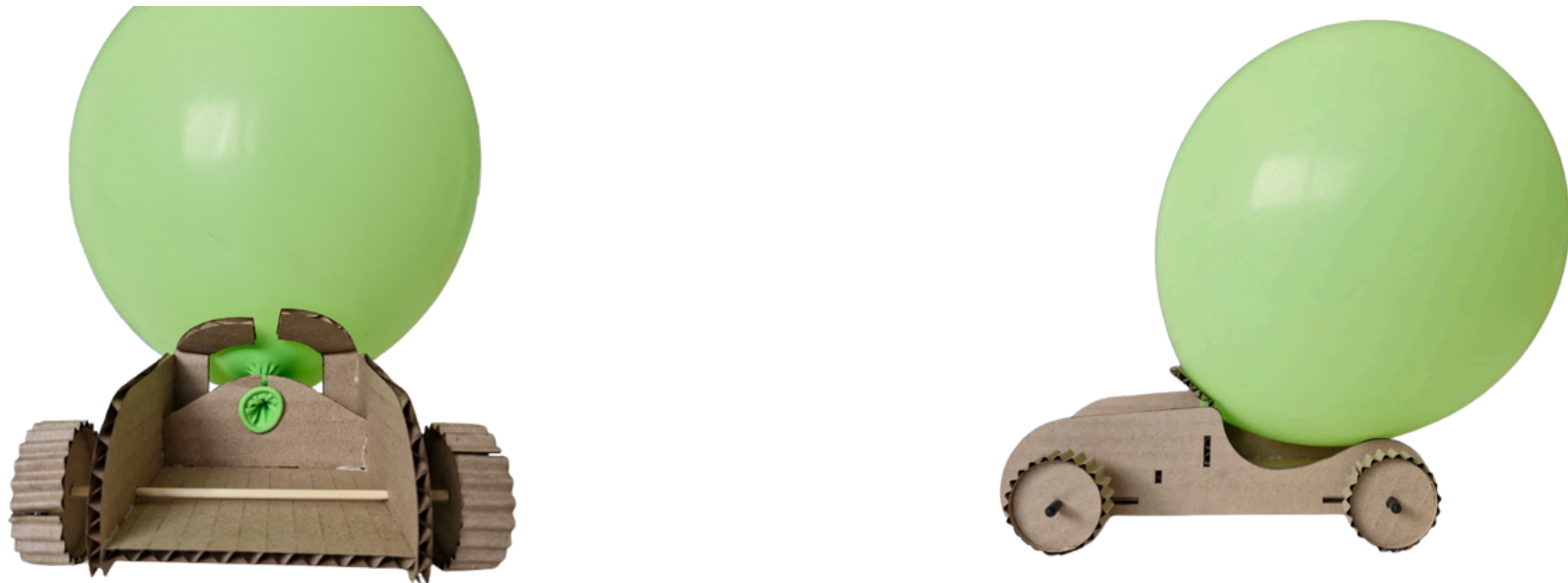


Do the same for all 4 skewers. Push the tubes onto each skewer until the wheel is snugly between the 2 tubes. Just don't make it too tight to the point where the wheel cannot turn.

The balloon should be blown up before slotting it into the car, the images above are for reference only.



Once you have blown up your balloon and slotted it into the car as in the image above, let go of the balloon and watch your car shoot forward!
